Volunteering at Hands on Hartford

- **\$1.4M** to community organizations
- **\$2M** in COVID-19 response grants since 2020
- **20K** members
- **59** local employees in Connecticut
- **\$11.9M** spent with local businesses
- **\$185K** spent with diverse-owned businesses



## Regional Impact

**\$16M+** to community organizations in 2021

*In grants, matching gifts, sponsorships, in-kind and other donations to nonprofit organizations in Connecticut, Maine, Massachusetts, New Hampshire, and Rhode Island*

- **\$7.4M** in Foundation grants
- **\$2.3M** from employees, board members and the Foundation through our Match Program
- **\$2.2M** in corporate and Foundation sponsorship support
- Nearly **\$190K** in volunteer service (5,369 hours)

Our heritage organizations, Harvard Pilgrim Health Care and Tufts Health Plan, gave more than \$200 million to community organizations through their foundations prior to our combination.

## Point32Health employees support community nonprofits

- Nearly \$193K to more than **40 Connecticut nonprofit organizations** through employee giving programs
- **146 volunteer hours** with Connecticut nonprofits
- **Our Walk to End Alzheimer's team** has contributed nearly \$1.4M to **the Alzheimer's Association** since 2012; our fundraising places us among the top 15 teams in the country

## Our Foundation works with community to support, advocate and advance healthier lives for everyone

**In 2021, 33 Connecticut organizations received grants totaling nearly \$875K. Highlights:**

- \$180,000 three-year grant to **Center for Food Equity and Economic Development at the Council of Churches of Greater Bridgeport** to support the FEED Mobile Marketplace and increase access to healthy food
- \$65,000 to **Center for Medicare Advocacy, Inc.**, to advocate for policy and practice changes that improve nursing home care statewide
- \$70,000 grant to **the Agency on Aging of South Central Connecticut** to support all five Connecticut area agencies on aging to design a unified statewide system to deliver aging information and services
- \$50,000 to **Health Equity Solutions**, an organization that has made accurate, timely information about COVID-19 vaccines and treatments accessible to diverse communities
- \$10,000 Momentum Fund grant to **Partnership for New Communities**, an organization that fosters vibrant communities to eliminate homelessness and create homes for older adults
